### **HUDCO Posts Robust Financial** Results for Q1 of FY 2025-26

The Board of Directors of Housing & Urban Development Corporation Ltd. (HUDCO), in its meeting held on August 6, 2025, approved the financial results for the first quarter of FY 2025-26, showcasing yet another record performance. It has been observed in the past that during the monsoon season, specifically around Independence Day, a large number of people fly kites. It has also been noticed that many people use metal coated Manjha to make it stronger. When this metal coated manjha comes in contact with live wires it causes tripping resulting in blackout of the area fed by the affected line and can cause serious injuries to the kite flyers or even may result in death of the person. The extra high voltage transmission lines are the corridor to transmit bulk power feeding the larger areas. Whenever there is a tripping due to entangling of kites it takes considerable time to locate and remove the kite from the line therefore it may result in outage for a long time. "While flying kites the people should stay away from

### Citizens' group in Gurugram objects to clearing of forest area

### The Hindu Bureau GURUGRAM

The Aravalli Bachao Citizens Movement (ABCM) on Tuesday objected to the flattening of a patch of the forest area in Sector 54 of Gurugram for reforestation as part of the "Matri Van" project inaugurated by Chief Minister Nayab Saini on August 2.

The citizen-led initiative, focused on protecting the Aravalli mountain range from environmental degradation, alleged that the action violated several laws protecting forests and the environment, including the Indian Forest Act, the Forest (Conservation) Act, and the Wildlife (Protection) Act.

Repeated calls and text

messages to the Divisional Forest Officer (DFO), Gurugram, did not elicit any

response. ABCM trustees Vaishali Rana and Colonel (retd.) S.S. Oberoi, in a letter to the DFO, asked why a patch with a thick green canopy was being used for reforestation. Calling it an instance of "wrong prioritisation", they wrote:

"The reason seems obvious - to provide recreational facilities to the adultra-luxury apartments being constructed by private builders."

Attaching purported videos of the forest area being cleared, the citizens' group termed the action "total destruction of the habitat and the nests".

# AMU students' stir against hike in tuition fee enters fifth day

The protest on the Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) campus entered the fifth day on Tuesday, with students continuing to boycott classes in large numbers, a senior faculty

The students have been demanding the rollback of the hike in annual fee, the conduct of long-pending students' union elections, which have not been held for eight years, and the removal of certain university officials allegedly responsible for the standoff.

Several Opposition MPs have written to AMU Vice-Chancellor Prof. Naima Khatoon expressing concern over the crackdown against the protest by the police and the university administration on Friday, when students were offering collective Friday prayers at the dharna site.

Congress MP from Saharanpur Imran Masood urged the Vice-Chancellor


