- The Academic Council made the following suggestions:
 - The Python Programming Skill-Oriented Course for CSE is a core course. Therefore, it
 was decided to replace it with a new skill-oriented course for CSE.
 - The council suggested providing prerequisites for learning Embedded Systems and IoT for the II Year I Semester of the Mechanical Engineering program.
 - 3. The council recommended renaming the Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning course for the II Year II Semester of the Mechanical Engineering program.
 - The council suggested placing the Design Thinking & Innovation course under the Engineering Science course category.
- Furthermore, the Academic Council discussed and resolved to approve the Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), course objectives, Course Outcomes, and the CO-PO & PSO mapping matrix for all B.Tech programs, as presented by the chairpersons of the respective Boards of Studies. (Appended in Annexure-4)
