Item No: 06-BOS-1:

Resolved to introduce the **Choice Based Credit Course-** in the III B.Tech II semester, IV B.Tech I Semester & II semester.

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Minutes of the Combined Boards of Studies meeting held at 10.00 a.m. on Sunday the 5th June 2016.

1. Implementation of Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) : - 4 Year B.Tech. Course.

Resolved to conduct 2 mid examinations in each semester, the first mid examination after the completion of two units and the 2nd mid examination after the completion of the remaining three units as already decided in the previous Boards of Studies meetings. But instead of considering the best one mid examination out of the two, it is resolved to give weightage to both the mid examinations in the ratio of 70% and 30% for the better performed mid examination and the other mid examination. However, the student who has missed one or both the mid examinations will be permitted to appear for a mid exam in the 2nd, 3rd & 4th units which will be a substitute for one missed mid exam. This is to be conducted before the commencement of end semester exams, can be even outside the working hours, can be even two mid exams a day. 20 internal marks will be allotted to these mid examinations. Seven (7) internal marks will be allotted for the continuous evaluation, the method of evaluation for allotting for these marks will be varying from subject to subject, which will be decided by the teacher dealing the subject in consultation with the Head of the Department and that method announced to the students clearly in the beginning of the semester.

In each subject, three internal marks will be allocated to the students based on the attendance, one mark if the attendance put in is more than 75%, one more mark if the attendance is more than 80% and one more mark if the attendance is more than 90%.

- 2. Classification of the Subjects :** It is resolved to include foundation courses to the extent of 30%, programme core and programme elective subjects to the extent of 60%, open electives and mandatory courses to the tune of 10% approximately of the total credits.
- 3.** It is resolved to introduce audit courses namely Professional Ethics, Stress Management, Advanced English Communication laboratory to all the students. No weightage in the form of credits is given to these courses but attendance for these courses will be counted for taking a decision to permit the student for end examinations / condonation / detention.
- 4.** At the end of each even semester examinations, after the publication of the results for that semester, an advanced supplementary examination will be conducted for the even semester subjects and the results will be announced before the commencement of classwork for the next semester.

5. It is resolved to permit the student for an improvement examination in the semester end examination if the student so desires, inspite of securing pass mark in that end examination. The student can utilize this facility for improvement in the immediate next semester examinations, however, without applying for the marks statement of the present semester.
6. It is resolved to give weightage of two credits for an internship of three weeks duration and more, when a student undergoes internship / industrial training from the specified industries / research organizations / Universities. In such a case, the student has to submit a report on that internship which will be evaluated by a team of three faculty members (decided by the HOD) of the department for those two credits. Student is given a chance to drop one seminar in place of a successful internship / industrial training.
7. It is resolved to schedule two theory subjects, a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course), a seminar and a project work in the IV B.Tech. II-Sem. The two theory subjects can be core or elective subjects. MOOC can be an elective subject.
8. It is resolved to permit the student to select one of the extra curricular / extension activities like NSS / Sports / Games / Cultural activities and issue a certificate to the extent that the student has completed this activity successfully. A certificate in one of these activities is a must for the student to become eligible for the award of Provisional Certificate or Degree.
9. It is resolved to award 4 credits for one SCI journal publication when a student publishes the paper as the main author. He/She may be allowed to drop one elective subject in this place.
10. It is resolved to formulate the regulations to suite the above minutes in each of the branches of Engineering for B.Tech, M.Tech, MBA & MCA courses suitably.
