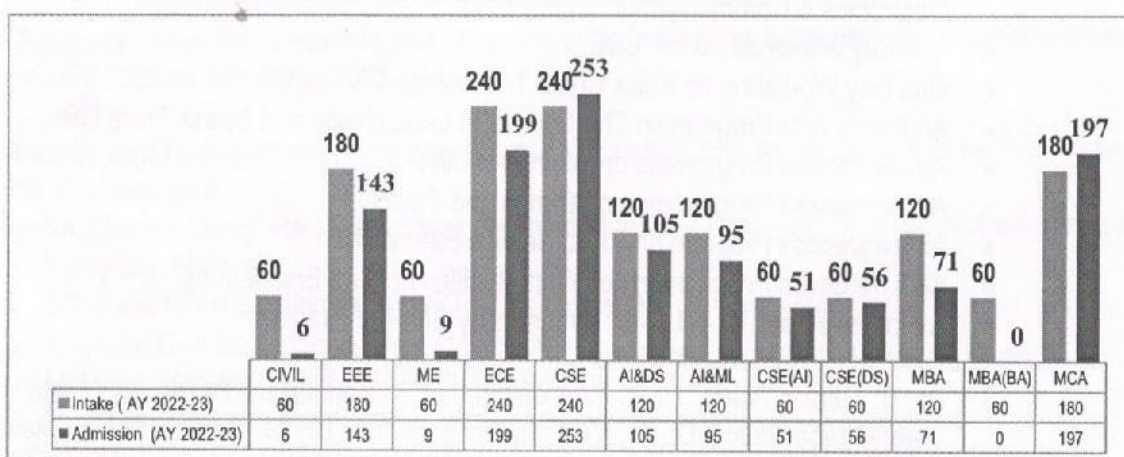
12.8: Presentation of information regarding the faculty appointments and relieving from 1st July, 2022 to 30th June, 2023.
