2. Received recommendations for ME – R19 regulations as below:
  - i. Mandatory course in I Semester - Constitution of India recommended to be replaced with Essence of Indian Traditional Knowledge in IV Semester.
  - ii. Python course can be an elective instead of regular subject.
  - iii. C & Data structure can be included in python as one or two units instead of separate course in the II semester.
  - iv. To reach the level of conducting experiments in Physics & C Chemistry laboratories as per APSCHE, alternative source is to be identified for those labs at PG colleges in around for demonstration.
  - v. Suggested to have a better name for 'English for competitive exams' in V Semester.
  - vi. 'Numerical Methods, Probability and Statistics' subject in IV Semester syllabus has to be considered for rearrangement with more content of Probability and statistics.
