AA Ranking to AITS NPTEL Chapter



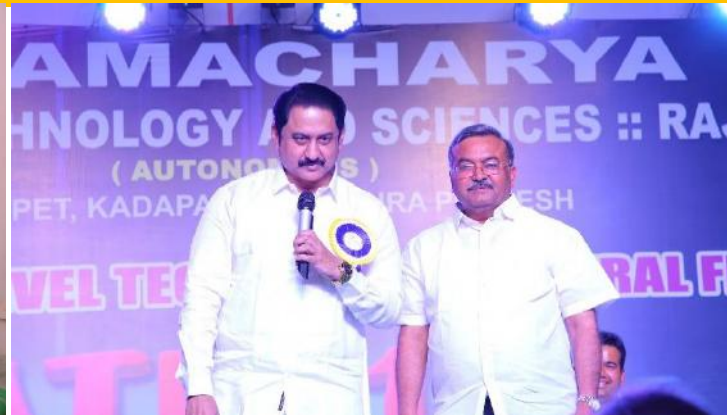
